

BBC Comedy Collective Terms and Conditions of Entry

What you need to submit

A completed online application form which includes:

A personal statement of no more than 500 words

Examples of your work:

Writer: minimum of 20 pages of script plus a logline on the title page

Director: a showreel of maximum 10 minutes Producer: detailed account of work to date Editor: a showreel of maximum 10 minutes

How to submit

Visit the <u>BBC Commissioning website</u> to find out more and apply.

Deadline: Wednesday 31 January 2024

<u>Submission guidelines</u>

Candidates can submit individually or as part of a writing or directing duo (maximum of two people).

Only ONE entry per person is permitted, and you can only enter for ONE role.

Producers and Editors can only submit individually.

In dual applications there needs to be a personal statement from both applicants.

Writers should include a logline on the title page of the script sample.

Writers are encouraged to submit 20 pages of a narrative comedy rather than sketches or multiple extracts.

Applicants should not use WeTransfer for showreels as it expires after a week.

Prospective applicants are strongly encouraged to reapply, even if they have submitted

The selected entrants will receive the following during a period of one year from being selected:

up to £10,000 worth of paid shadowing on a BBC Comedy a £5,000 bursary to put towards a material at the end of their shadowing placement "Fee
