BBC Complaints to the BBC: December 2016

The BBC answered over **13,500** complaints from the audience during December 2016. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised this month included complaints from Radio 2 listeners who were disappointed by the quality of the programme The Christmas That Goes Wrong, broadcast on Christmas Day.

We also received complaints from some people who felt there was too much coverage of the death of George Michael over Christmas.
