Complaints to the BBC: January 2015

The BBC answered just over **20,000** complaints from the audience during January 2015. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised included complaints about some of the analysis during FA Cup Match of the Day on 25th January which some viewers felt might encourage foul play.

The outfit worn by pop-star Rita Ora on The One Show on 5th January also generated complaints from viewers who felt it was too revealing.

Finally, the decision to devote most of New Year's Day to an adaptation of Tol War and Peace brought complaints from some Radio 4 listeners who felt it took up too much of the schedule.
